

NBSRT-SJ FALL LUNCHEON OCTOBER 20, 2016

The meeting was called to order by the President, Barry Harbinson. Nancy Steele, who led the meeting in the singing of O Canada, offered grace.

Netta Chase, Chairperson of the Scholarship Committee, introduced Mechlin Aidemouni who is this year's recipient of the NBSRTSJ scholarship. Miss Aidemouni, a graduate of Saint Malachy's High School is enrolled in the Science Program at UNBSJ with the aim of continuing studies in optometry. She was accompanied by Marion J.
